

Situational Curses

1Peter 5:8, John 5:19

- a. **Taking on second heaven spirits** Col :13-18 13. For He delivered us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,14. in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.15. And He is the image of the invisible God, the first-born of all creation.16. For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities all things have been created by Him and for Him.17. And He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. 18. He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the first-born from the dead; so that He Himself might come to have first place in everything.
- b. **Trespassing on satanic property** (even internet)
 - i. Satanic places or occult places (satan worship)
 - ii. Catholic, Mormon, Freemason, Jehovahs witness, Muslim, Buddhist, Hindu
 - iii. Mexico ruins and Querétaro
 - iv. Going to other countries and their culture: Egyptian, African, Indian,
- c. **Touching the unclean** 1Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore Come ye out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, And touch no unclean thing; And I will receive you,
 - i. Occult or satanic things
 - ii. What we have watched, listened to
 - iii. What we have had on our property

Things done as kids: Bloody Mary, Light as a feather, séances, wather-witching, blood brothers, drinking blood, Indian rain or fire dances, sex magick, Ouiji Boards, celebrating Halloween, Haunted houses, pacts with satan.

Trauma: Making self passout, hypnosis, car wrecks, knocked unconscious, passing out drunk or high, blood transfusions, or transplants, or even very emotionally painful times in our lives can open us up to the enemy.

- d. **Entering battles we were not called into** Numbers 14:39-45
- e. **Scriptural Steps in taking on a battle:** Get God's strategy like Joshua did at Jericho (Joshua 6)
 - i. Cleansing the land through vicarious repentance
 - ii. Petitioning God's Courtroom
 - iii. Prayer, Fasting, Worship, and Evangelism
