

Conquering Rebellion

Jesus' example: Philippians 2: 6. who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7. but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. 8. And being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death**, even death on a cross.

John 14: 15. "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.

1. Rebellion with your parents
2. Rebellion with teachers, principals, coaches, etc....
3. Rebellion against civil laws and police
4. Rebellion in marriage: Husband taking responsibility in leading and commanding and disciplining, Wife obeying in all things as unto the Lord.
5. Rebellion at the work place: Do you obey the rules and those over you
6. Rebellion by running down national leaders
7. Rebellion in the local church: Do you submit to church leadership

Hebrews 13: 17. Obey your leaders, and submit to them; for they keep watch over your souls, as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you.
