1. Jesus reveals the nature of satan: John 10:10 The thief comes

- a. only to steal b. and kill c. and destroy;
- d. I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

2. The devourer and destroyer:

Joel 2:25 I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten— the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm— my great army that I sent among you. ²⁶ You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, and you will praise the name of the LORD your God, who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be shamed. ²⁷ Then you will know that I am in Israel, that I am the LORD your God, and that there is no other; never again will my people be shamed.

Zeph 3:20 At that time I will gather you; at that time I will bring you home. I will give you honor and praise among all the peoples of the earth when I restore your fortunes before your very eyes,” says the LORD.

Job 42:10 The LORD restored the fortunes (turned the captivity) of Job when he prayed for his friends, and the LORD increased all that Job had twofold.

Hosea 6:1 Come, let us return to the LORD. He has torn us to pieces but he will heal us; he has injured us but he will bind up our wounds.

Satan is the destroyer, but sometimes God will allow a season of troubles to perfect us and do a work in us that nothing else would accomplish. The trials refine us.

3. Take a Look at your family Tree: Willow Tree (Ps 137:2-4) or Oak of Righteousness (Gen 35:8, Isaiah 61:3)? Derek Prince gives these indications of a family curse on a family bloodline based on Deuteronomy 28 and Leviticus 26:

1. A history of physical or mental breakdown
2. Repeated chronic sickness
3. Barrenness or tendency to miscarry
4. Divorce or family alienation
5. Continual financial stress or poverty

6. Accident prone- repeated unexplained accidents

7. History of suicide or early deaths

a. Palmerworm (**gnawer** worm stage "gazam" in Hebrew-health or mental/emotional problems)

b. Locust (**swarmer** stage "arbeh" in Hebrew- strange unexplained accidents, poverty, lack, famine, overlooked, or under-appreciated)

c. Cankerworm (**devourer** stage "yeqek" in Hebrew- divorce, or family alienation)

d. Catetapiller (**consumer** "chaciyl" in Hebrew- suicide, barrenness, miscarriages, SIDS, or early deaths)

4. Have faith in God to see the turn around with YOU Hosea 4:6 "my people destroyed for lack of knowledge

Sins that bring curses on family lines

The worship of other gods (ties to freemasonry, Catholic Idolatry, Native American), Occult (dark arts), Sexual Sins, Murder, Violent Criminal Activity, Marking the Body, or Substance Abuse

1. Strong drink and violence (Hab 2:15-17 giving strong drink- violence) 2. Spoken Curses (Prov 18:21) 3. Loshon Hara: a tale-bearer (Duet. 27:24) 4. Ungodly Anger (Gen 49:7 cursed be their anger) 5. Greed: Lack of being a tither and giver falls under this (Lk 6:38, Pr 28:27, Mal 3:8-9) 6. Witchcraft: of the flesh, or the dark arts (Gal 5:19) 7. Harming the Innocent: Shedding innocent blood, or oppressing the weak, poor, or defenseless (Pr 6:16-19, Deut 27:19) 8. The curse of anti-Semitism or racism (Gen 12:3) 9. Legalism and religious spirit: control and Pharisee spirit, church splitters, rebellious (Mt 16:6 yeast of Pharisees) 10. Dishonoring Parents (Eph 6:1-3) 11. Suicide (Rev 6:8) 12. Bitterness (Mt 6:12-15) 13. Cursed Objects (Deut 7:25) 14. Family Trauma 15. Actual Witchcraft Curse put on a family (2 Kings 3:27)

Little known Biblical Curses:

- Children pledged to marry but given to another (divorce) Deut 28:30
- Children go into captivity Deut 28:41
- Insanity because of sexual perversions Lev 18:23 Confusion (depraved minds) Rom 1
- Dart through the liver because of adultery Prov 7:23
- Illegitimate pregnancies "cannot enter the assembly" Deut 23:2
- Sign of a curse women and children rule over them Isaiah 3:12
