Intro: Lead up to the second Temple period (glory greater, but temple inferior)
The Great Reformation and Asuza: God wants all the Glory

1. Dealing with Root Issues: Matthew 3:10

Pride, Fear, Rebellion, Unforgiveness, Lust (renewed mind), and Personal Deliverance

2. Leviathan is the spirit of Pride Matthew 23:12

- Hinders promotion and keeps you locked into a wilderness experience
- Hinders God's presence and receiving from God (counterfeits God's Holy Place, soul instead of Spirit; false revelation and peace)
- Hinders prayer and Bible study
- Helps cause great falls into sin and destruction
- This spirit is fiercely generational and traffics in generational curses

Job 41 God was dealing with Job's Pride

False Humility

- By avoiding luxuries (outwardly humble)
- Measuring by outward things (how long prayed, fasted, etc...)
- Insecure or self hatred (pride strongly comes out of insecurities because people want to feel good about themselves)

Defeating Leviathan

1. Job 41: 8. "Lay your hand on him; Remember the battle; you will not do it again!"
2. Deep repentance
3. This is truly God's battle:
 - a. Psalm 74: 14. **Thou didst crush the heads of Leviathan;** Thou didst give him as food for the creatures of the wilderness. 15. Thou didst break open springs and torrents; Thou didst dry up ever-flowing streams.
 - b. Isaiah 27: 1. In that day **the Lord will punish Leviathan** the fleeing serpent, With His fierce and great and mighty sword, Even Leviathan the twisted serpent; And He will kill the dragon who lives in the sea.
 - c. Isaiah 45: 1. Thus says the Lord to Cyrus His anointed, Whom I have taken by the right hand, To subdue nations before him, And to loose the loins of kings; To open doors before him so that gates will not be shut: 2. "I will go before you and make the rough places smooth; **I will shatter the doors of bronze, and cut through their iron bars. 3. "And I will give you the treasures of darkness, And hidden wealth of secret places,**In order that you may know that it is I, The Lord, the God of Israel, who calls you by our name. 4. "For the sake of Jacob My servant, And Israel My chosen one,

There are many scriptures that instruct God's people to be meek and humble (Matt 18:4; Luke 14:11; 18:14; John 13:14-17). The apostles also taught all Christians to be humble (1Tim 1:15-17; 1Pet 5:6). Proverbs 18:12 points out the difference between pride and humility: "Before destruction the heart of man is haughty and before honor is humility."

Pride self check

- Hate to be corrected or disciplined
- Blaming others (even blaming the devil)
- Independence
- Critical or fault-finding of others
- Moving into battles in presumption
- Cannot take constructive criticism
- Defend pet doctrines and very territorial
- Have difficulty admitting wrong and/or apologizing
- Difficulty submitting to authority (have relational issues with people in authority over you)
- Don't understand how to show respect to those in authority over you
- Lack of patience with others in their sin
- Self Righteousness and spiritual pride (taking pride in what God has done in your life)
- Performance measuring and measuring success about external things
- Desiring and yearning for praise and compliments
- Rejoicing in the Failures of others
- You compulsively defend yourself (against wrong impressions or criticism)
- Fake or exaggerate knowledge (one upping people)
- Not risk takers (play it safe and want to be admired doesn't want to fail)
- Cannot praise others or give proper honor
- Compulsive interrupting people or talk continually dominating the conversation
