

# Protocol of Heaven

## Part 8

### *From the Tabernacle into Warfare*

#### **Intro: Offering Box in the outer court**

#### **1. Divine Revelation: Beyond natural understanding and thinking**

1Cor 2: 1. And when I came to you, brethren, I did not come with superiority of speech or of wisdom, proclaiming to you the testimony of God. 2. For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. 3. And I was with you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling. 4. And my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, 5. that your faith should not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God. 6. Yet we do speak wisdom among those who are mature; a wisdom, however, not of this age, nor of the rulers of this age, who are passing away; 7. but we speak God's wisdom in a mystery, the hidden wisdom, which God predestined before the ages to our glory; 8. the wisdom which none of the rulers of this age has understood; for if they had understood it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory; 9. but just as it is written, **"Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, 10. For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God. 11. For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the spirit of the man, which is in him? Even so the thoughts of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.** 12. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things freely given to us by God, 13. which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words. 14. But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised. 15. But he who is spiritual appraises all things, yet he himself is appraised by no man. 16. For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he should instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.

#### **2. From ministering to the Lord to going to war**

- a. Ministering to the Lord: fresh anointing, fresh revelation, spiritual strength
- b. Putting on the armor:
  - i. Helmet of knowing God's word and meditating on the word of God
  - ii. Breastplate of righteousness: faith in God's word
  - iii. Belt of Truth: knowing sound doctrine and established in truth
  - iv. Shoes of peace: staying in peace is a great key to victory
  - v. Sword of using God's word against the enemy
  - vi. Shield of Faith: Big enough to cover all it needs to
- c. Revelation is the key to victory in warfare and total deliverance

#### **3. Divine Revelation from the Lord**

- a. Rejection:
  - i. Not loving oneself (self-rejection)

- ii. Being rejected by others
- iii. Rejecting others
- iv. Feeling rejected or abandoned by God
- v. Rejecting God (satan's greatest goal)
- vi. Generational curse or spirits linked to rejection
- vii. People get into a lot of sin because of looking for acceptance
- viii. Death and suicide traffic powerfully with a spirit of rejection
- ix. Generational curse linked with rejection

**b. Rejection leads to anger:**

- i. Temper, lack of self control
- ii. Hate, anger, rage, murder, and abuse
- iii. Strife and bickering
- iv. Road rage
- v. Fighting and violence
- vi. Criminal activity
- vii. Generational curse linked with anger

**c. Anger leads to unforgiveness** which will turn into bitterness

- i. Refusing to release a person
- ii. Holding a grudge
- iii. Bitterness is a spiritual "cancer of the soul"

**d. Unforgiveness allows satanic bondage and torment**

- i. People are put in spiritual prison
- ii. People are given over to spiritual tormentors

**4. This destructive cycle** of *rejection to anger to unforgiveness to bondage* can be a sign of a generation curse and can attempt to cycle throughout the life of an individual and down a family line.
