

The Doctrine of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit

1. A secondary experience after salvation:

water Acts 19:1-7, 1Cor 10, salvation 1Cor 12:12-13, into Holy Spirit Matt 3:11

- a. Jesus blew on disciples (salvation) John 20:21-22, Luke 24:45
- b. They were to pray and wait in Jerusalem Luke 24:49, Acts 1:8
- c. How do we receive the baptism in the Holy Spirit Galatians 3:13
- d. Examples in scripture: Acts 8 Samaria, Acts 19

2. What happens at the Baptism in the Holy Spirit Acts 10:38

- a. Clothing of power Luke 24:49
- b. Moving into the supernatural side of Christianity
- c. Prayer language Mark 16:16-18, Gifts of the Spirit are activated (blue tunic)

3. When are tongues appropriate 1 Corinthians 14

- a. Outside four walls 1 Cor 14:22
- b. Worship in Spirit and truth John 4:21-23
- c. When praying Romans 8:26
- d. As long as it is not disrupting the service

Benefits of Praying in Tongues It edifies yourself (strengthens you) 1Cor 14:4

- You utter mysteries (great revelation comes into your life) 1Cor 14:2
- The Holy Spirit prays through you the perfect will of God Rom 8:26
- It is part of your armor Eph 6:18
- It sharpens your discernment (helps you get spiritually sensitive)
- Builds up your most holy faith Jude 20
- The enemy cannot understand what you are praying (it is a heavenly language)
- You will stay in the perfect will of God (because the Holy Spirit prays that over you and those that are in your prayer circle)
- You will be strengthened by the power of the Holy Spirit Eph 3:16
- It is true worship John 4:23

4. The Accuser vs the Intercessor Rev 12:10

- a. The accuser bring division and fault-finds, criticizes, tears down, and wants to see the destruction or downfall of others. Competition
- b. The intercessor sees the problems, but has Christ's heart to sincerely pray for people and ministries.
- c. Knowing your identity in Christ: Matt 3:17, Matt 4:3

5. Realms of authority Hebrews 13:17

- a. Pastors that have abdicated their authority within the local church
- b. Husbands who have abdicated their authority within the family structure

6. Peter's victory

- a. Believing a lie or false doctrine, and claims never Matt 26:31-35
- b. Jesus rebukes him Matt 16:23
- c. He denies the faith Mark 14, Mark 16:7
- d. Jesus has to restore him John 21:15-19
- e. He still is dealing with this mindset (Acts 1:8)
- f. But he ends up being one of the greatest champions of the early church Acts 2
