

What Christ Paid for at the Cross

Galatians 3:13 “Christ has redeemed (purchased your freedom) from the curse of the Law by becoming a curse for you. For it is written (in the Old Testament Deut 21:23) cursed is anyone who hangs on a tree. He redeemed you in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.”

Introduction: The **nine curses** for disobedience of the law are: humiliation, barrenness, unfruitfulness, mental or physical breakdown, family breakdown, poverty or famine, defeat, oppression, failure, and God’s disfavor. The **seven blessings** for obedience to the law are listed (blessings given to Abraham): exaltation, health, reproductiveness, prosperity, abundance, God’s favor, victory over enemies.

Signs of a possible Generational Curse on your family line:

1. A history of physical or mental breakdown
2. Repeated chronic sickness
3. Barrenness or tendency to miscarry
4. Divorce or family alienation
5. Continual financial stress or poverty
6. Accident prone: repeated unexplained accidents
7. History of suicide or early deaths

Sign there may be evil spirits at work tormenting the life of an individual:

Fits of rage, constant headaches, migraines, insomnia, incurable diseases, fears, mental illness, seizures, suicidal thoughts, problems with reproductive organs, depression, addictions, fascination with the occult, nightmares, hearing voices, seeing scary visions, stubborn arrogance, compulsive dishonesty, marital problems, dizziness or fainting, or sharp unexplained pains in various parts of the body. Satan’s kingdom attacks body (health), soul (mental & emotional torment), spirit (difficulty praying, reading Bible etc.), night’s rest, relationships, finances, marriage, and ministries.

Breakdown of What Jesus Paid for on the Cross

1. **Sin** (missing the mark), **Transgression** (rebellion), **Iniquity** (bent, crooked, perverse) Is 53 Christ was pierced for transgression and bruised for iniquity
2. **Healing** (body, soul, spirit) 1Peter 2:24
3. **Deliverance** (6 hours and became a curse) Gal 3:13
4. **Poverty broken** (thorns on sweat of brow) Gen 3:17-19
5. **The Glory** (nudity) Gen 2:25 (from “partially nude”) then Gen 3:7 (from “totally nude”)
6. **Authority and power in hands and feet** Mark 16:17, Deut 11:24
7. Ability to **die to sin and live righteous** (what grace really is) 1 Pet 2:24
8. **The resurrection life of power** Rom 8:10-11, Phil 3:10-11
9. **Total victory over satan’s kingdom and death** Col 2:15, Eph 2:6, Eph 1:20-23
10. **Curse of the Law broken** Gal 3:13
11. **Seven places Jesus shed his blood**
 - a. Garden of Gethsemane: Luke 22:41-44 (will to chose God’s will over ours-submission to authority)
 - b. Whipping Post: 1 Peter 2:24
 - c. Crown of thorns: Mark 15:17
 - d. Nails in hands: Mark 16:18, Matt 10:1
 - e. Nails in feet: Luke 8 Man with legion of demons
 - f. Spear in side: inner healing was paid for by Christ’s broken heart
 - g. On the tree: Gal 3:13 deliverance was paid for

Galatians 3:13 Jesus paid for deliverance from:

Sickness of any kind, any oppression or defeat from enemies, mental and emotional disorders, insanity, struggles with sin, relational problems, poverty and lack, curse on the works of hands, being fearful, cursed home, lack of strength, transportation cursed, savings, labor in vain, demonic torment, marriage cursed, parent and child relationship cursed, confusion, kitchen and food cursed, no rain, drought blight and mildew, wild animals overtake you, live in terror, blindness, and skies above you brass and earth beneath you iron.

Psalm 125:3 “The scepter of the wicked will not remain over the land (promised land) allotted to the righteous, for then the righteous might use their hands to do evil.”
