



Romans 8: 11 And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also ***give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.***

Exodus 23:25-26 You shall serve the Lord your God; He shall bless your bread and water, and ***I will take sickness from your midst.*** None shall lose her young by miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days.

Psalms 103:3 Who forgives [every one of] all your iniquities, ***Who heals [each one of] all your diseases,***

Psalms 107:20 He sent ***His word and healed them,*** And delivered them from their destructions.

Malachi 4:1-2 FOR BEHOLD, the day comes that shall burn like an oven, and all the proud and arrogant, yes, and all that do wickedly and are lawless, shall be stubble; the day that comes shall burn them up, says the Lord of hosts, so that it will leave them neither root nor branch. ***But unto you who revere and worshipfully fear My name shall the Sun of Righteousness arise with healing in His wings and His beams, and you shall go forth and gambol like calves [released] from the stall and leap for joy.***

James 5:14-16 Is anyone among you sick? He should call in the church elders (the spiritual guides). And they should pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Lord's name. ***And the prayer [that is] of faith will save [sozo] him who is sick, and the Lord will restore him; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.*** Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed and restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]. The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working].

1 Peter 2:24 He personally bore our sins in His [own] body on the tree [as on an altar and offered Himself on it], that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. ***By His wounds you have been healed.***

Galatians 3:13 Christ purchased our freedom [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation] by [Himself] ***becoming a curse for us,*** for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified);

Matthew 8:16-17 When evening came, they brought to Him many who were under the power of demons, and He drove out the spirits with a word and restored to health all who were sick. And thus He fulfilled what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, He Himself took [in order to carry away] our ***weaknesses and infirmities and bore away our diseases.***

Proverbs 4:20-23 My son, attend to my words; consent and submit to my sayings. Let them not depart from your sight; keep them in the center of your heart. Daily Faith Confessions

Proverbs 4:20-23 My son, attend to my words; consent and submit to my sayings. Let them not depart from your sight; keep them in the center of your heart.
